Shaw & Smith M3 Chardonnay 2015 84

Adelaide Hills, S.A.

Aiming for elegance, restraint and the ability to age: the acid brings freshness and there's generosity of flavour. Typically, it shows white flowers, citrus, and nectarine notes. The 2015 vintage is true to style. The palate is long and flavoursome, with mid-palate texture and bright acid. A note of brioche adds complexity.

Shaw & Smith M3 Chardonnay 2009 89

Adelaide Hills, S.A.

Brilliant pale straw colour with watery hue. The nose displays attractive notes of white peach, cashew and spicy oak followed by a hint of nougat and citrus as end notes. Excellent intensity and varietal character

Tolpuddle Chardonnay 2014 98

Coal River Valley, TAS

Light yellow hue, the bouquet showing very fresh, refined, cashew nut and creamy yeast lees aromas, tight and reserved. The palate backs this up, with very tight, fine, high-acid presence, which is positively Chablis-esque.

Tolpuddle Chardonnay 2015 128

Coal River Valley, TAS

Depth and level of chardonnay flavour is inherent, it's lightly creamy and opens gently with marzipan sweet-savouriness. This Tolpuddle showing is pure and quietly provides powerful citrus and green apple characters. A superbly flowing example of fantastic flavour that carries its complexity well.

Leeuwin Art Series Chardonnay 2013/2014, 120

Margaret River, WA

"Leeuwin Estate is about to release what I believe is Australia's greatest white wine, and the first I have given a score of 99- plus....It's a game changer. And it's given me a problem. You see, I gave the 2015 chardonnay 99 points, my highest score for an Australian white wine on release. But the problem now is that the 2016 is a better wine. I don't believe any wine has achieved perfection, but this one pushes it mighty close. So all I can do is give it 99-plus."

NV Mumm, 120

Champagne FRANCE

Meringue-like aromas, smooth and fruity, soft and open-knit, with a slight grip and more noticeable sweetness than any of the other Mumm portfolio.

- Yangarra Small Pot Whole Bunch Shiraz 2014 98
McLaren Vale, S.A.
While it's light on its feet, it's still strong at heart. Its dark berries are still dark, and its tannins dead serious, but the whole effect is one of easy satisfaction as much as mild stimulation. This could go either way; a serious lunchtime teaser or a big steak and candlelight luxury with linen and whatnot at night.
- Penfolds Bin 128 Coonawarra Shiraz 98
Coonawarra, S.A.
Bin 128 comprises fruit sourced from the unique terra rossa soils of Coonawarra, a region that exemplifies the perfume, transparency and seductive nature of cool-climate red table wines. Sage and bay leaf coupled with Indian spices and dark-berried fruits paired with consistent tell-tale French oak notes.
- Tolpuddle Pinot Noir 2015 120
Coal River Valley, TAS
Excellent colour; the bouquet is highly expressive and fragrant, with red fruits wrapped in notes of spice and forest that will continue to increase as the wine develops; the palate is similarly poised between primary fruit flavours and savoury secondary characters. Its greatest assets are its balance and, above all, length.
- Leeuwin Estate Art Series Cabernet Sauvignon 2011 139
Margaret River, WA
Deep, bright purple/red colour. The bouquet is also bold and bright, fresh and clean, with hi-fi chocolate and blackberry flavours, full body and powerful aftertaste. A big, bold, full-bodied cabernet with loads of panache.
- Shaw & Smith Balhannah Vineyard Shiraz 2014 149
Adelaide Hills, S.A.
Deep ruby colour with a tinge of purple. Intensely spicy aromas, with a trace of white pepper and a whiff of forest like stemmy character from the 70% whole-bunch fermentation. Background smoky notes; traces of chocolate and vanilla.
- Hickinbotham The Peake Cabernet Shiraz 13/14 165
McLaren Vale, S.A.
Exceptionally potent and powerful, initially giving the (false) impression its alcohol is more than 14%. Retasting brings it back into perspective, the two varieties bonded, yet each preserving its varietal integrity and structural architecture.

- Penfolds Bin 389 Cabernet Shiraz 220
Magill, S.A.
Bin 389 is often referred to as 'Baby Grange', in part because components of the wine are matured in the same barrels that held the previous vintage of Grange. Enticing, inviting with a taste continuum of assorted flavours and textures including a spoil of fruits meshed with a grain-like paste of oats, barley & wheat.
- Saltram No1 Shiraz 149
Barossa Valley, S.A.
Deep purple/red colour and a rich, ripe, toasty licoricey aroma; concentrated and inky. The palate holds masses of spice, licorice and black fruit flavours of great impact and power. Full-bodied, with masses of tannin. A sensational big red of a type the Barossa does so well.
- Grant Burge Holy Trinity GSM 2013 83
Barossa Valley, S.A.
This GSM is Grenache-dominant from older, deeper-rooted vines in the Barossa. The result is an amazing vibrant colour in the glass, great bright raspberry tart-like fruit flavours and white peppery and anise-like spices in a light coat of tannins. Delish.
- Wolf Blass Grey Label Shiraz, 69
McLaren Vale, S.A.
Very deep, dense, dark red/purple colour. The bouquet is super-ripe and almost jammy, with rich, opulent qualities, but the palate is more serious with firm, tight structure and full-body, backed up by abundant dry, savoury tannins. A big, solid wine with liberal but balanced oak and appealingly fleshy palate texture. It's big but already approachable.
- Rockbarr Coonawarra Cutie Shiraz 2014 85
McLaren Vale, S.A.
An attractive, elegant, medium bodied palate displaying sumptuous mulberry, blackcurrant pastille, pomegranate and red currant fruit. An abundance of natural acidity carries right through the palate, providing structural support and balances the ripe fruit. The palate blissfully culminates in a very lingering fashion aided by a horde of supple, velvety tannin leaving behind a smack of cocoa to savour.
- Leeuwin Estate Art Series Shiraz 2013 120
Margaret River, WA
Deep, youthful red/purple colour; the bouquet all about vanilla, chocolate and smooth plum-berry flavours. The texture is glossy and gentle, rounded and balanced, with good length.
